"Dogs of Town Hall" is the kid series I create and publish on YouTube. The kids show features my preschooler as the leader of a pack of dogs, and has talking stuffed animals, animation, and live-action. Some of the main characters include Avery (my 3yr old) as the leader of the pack, Rusty, Sampson, Dach, Butters, Cerberus, Blaze, Rocky, and Jasper the cat. The show is a tool for us to overcome our various anxiety issues and has helped us tremendously these past few months. On occasion, the "Dogs of Town Hall" will feature "guest stars" to voice act for visiting characters. In fact, there is a recent collaboration where the dogs go to visit "Tina from Not All That Sparkles Shines" and learn how to bake chocolate chip cookies together. The show is best for kids ages 2-8 years old, but it is made to be entertaining to people of all ages. This is not just another annoying kids show, and we aim to make it enjoyable by everyone, especially the parents.
